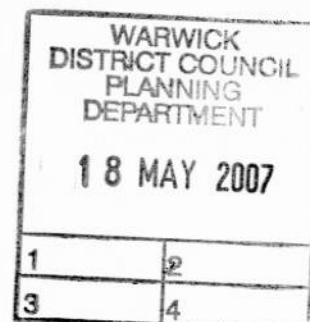

**PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004 – WARWICK STATEMENT OF
COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT (SCI) SUBMISSION DRAFT – APRIL 2007**

Thank you for consulting the Government Office for the West Midlands on the above document.

It is pleasing to see that the majority of the comments we made on the Consultation Draft SCI have been taken on board.

We consider that the document meets the tests of soundness contained in PPS12. However, there are a few points which we would like you to take on board which will improve the clarity of the document.

Para 9.3 – Should be clarified. The text should be amended to refer to the fact that Warwick County Council has responsibility for Minerals Waste and Planning Applications and the Warwickshire County Council SCI provides the framework for Community Involvement in Minerals and Waste Planning Applications.

Table 2 – For consistency it would be useful to include a footnote about the email alert system as in Table 3.

Table 6 – A key needs adding for *, (1) and (2).

Appendix 1 – “Numbering” of Other Consultees needs amending – both (ii) and (jj) are listed twice.
